Coaches are responsible for supervising their swimmers in both warm up and swim down.

Qualified Swimmers including the 2 Reserves not wishing to take part in a final are required to inform the Recorders no later than 15 minutes after the last Individual Event in the Session.

MEDALS:

• Medals shall be awarded to the top 3 swimmers in each event .

• Medals for the 800/1500m events can be collected from the President during the Heats once the results have been announced.

• Failure of a swimmer to collect their medal in the relevant session will result in the swimmer forfeiting his/her medal.
