## Invitational Shrimp Gala SATURDAY 14<sup>™</sup> OCTOBER 2023 Tynemouth Pool



- 1. The meet will be swum under ASA Laws and Technical Rules and will be as a [Level 4].
- The pool length is 25m of variable depth with 6 lanes & anti-wave lane ropes; a separate swim down facility is available. It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that the swim facility is used correctly – in the event that it is not, the pool will be closed.
- 3. Swiss Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times and places shown on the electronic scoreboard are for information only, and are not necessarily the official result.
- 4. There will be no strobe available.
- 5. There will be no backstroke ledges used.
- 6. Events will be all strokes 50m plus 100 Freestyle (8,9,10y) 100IM (8,9,10y), 200IM (11,12 yrs), 200 Freestyle (11,12yrs). All events will be HDW. (Heat Declared Winner)
- 7. Gender categories are Male/Open or Female.
- 8. The Female category is for birth sex females in accordance with Swim England's Transgender and Non-Binary Competition Policy. By entering the 'Female' category, a swimmer confirms that their birth sex is female.
- 9. Entrants can only compete in one gender category for the duration of the meet.
- 10. Entries will be accepted from rankings and training times. If there is no time entered then the swimmer will be rejected from the event.
- 11. Upper limit times will apply. Swimmers must not have swam faster than the upper time limit and any swimmers entered on times above the upper time for their age and event <u>will be excluded</u>. All entry times must be converted to 25m pool times by use of the ASA Conversion tables. Entries <u>may</u> be limited to comply with session limits. Should the meet be oversubscribed, entries will be rejected on the basis of slowest submitted times in each age group.
- 12. Age Groups are 8 yrs, 9 yrs, 10 yrs, 11 yrs, 12 yrs Age as at 14th October 2023.
- 13. Medals will be issued to the first six places in age groups 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in events as listed above.
- 14. Poolside entries will not be accepted.
- 15. Entry Fees

- 17. Entries should be submitted via sportsystems or entry form and should be e-mailed to Julie Row on <u>admin@newcastleswimteam.co.uk</u> by Friday 29<sup>th</sup> September 2023 at 12 noon.
- 18. Any withdrawal should be notified to the recorders by 8.15am for the morning session and 45 minutes prior to the commencement of the afternoon session.
- 19. Refunds will only be given:
  - Where a competitor whose entry has been accepted, has to withdraw on medical grounds subject to an
    appropriate medical certificate being received by the Meet Promoter.
  - Should a swimmer withdraw from an event on medical grounds they will be removed from all events.

20. Coaches/Team Managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Failure to report to marshalling in good time may result in elimination from the event.

- 21. For safety reasons only swimmers who can perform an ASA competitive start may perform a shallow racing dive from the starting blocks. Where appropriate, over the top starts will be used during the meet. Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool. Anyone who is unable to dive from the blocks or the side and has to do an in water start the club must notify the referees before the start of the session.
- 22. Access to pool-side will be restricted to swimmers, coaches, officials and authorised helpers in line with SE Child Protection Policy.
- 23. To comply with the Data Protection Act you agree that we may publish your personal information as part of the results of the event and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of insurance, licenses or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compare to other events. Results may include (but not limited to) name, any club affiliation, race times, age category.
- 24. The use of any photographic equipment (still, video or digital including mobile phones with photo facilities) by members of the public is strictly prohibited by North Tyneside Council and Newcastle Swim Team.
- 25. Neither Newcastle Swim Team nor North Tyneside MBC can be held responsible for loss or damage to spectators or swimmers property. A No Outdoor Footwear Policy exists in the changing village and on poolside and this will be enforced. We ask that you please inform your swimmer in advance of the gala so they can come prepared to comply with these requests.
- 26. The address for Tynemouth Pool is Preston Rd N, North Shields NE29 9PX. There is ample parking available near the pool, both outside the building and opposite in Morrison's car park. Parking fees may apply.
- 27. The Lead Referee for this event will be Brian Denholm. The referee's decision is final
- 28. Admission for spectators will be £10, children will be admitted for free.
- 29. A swimwear supplier may display over the weekend.

#### Any points not covered above will be at the discretion of the meet manager.
