Competition News - Galas, General Information for Beginners Part 2

A short time before a meet, the Competition Secretary will receive an accepted entries list and will return gala forms, via Coaches, to all swimmers who entered, confirming their accepted swims.

If the gala has been oversubscribed and there are rejections then this information will also be noted on the returned forms and any refund of fees will be processed as soon as possible and returned to parents by the Squad Reps. Sometimes a draft programme for the gala will be supplied to the Competition Secretary and this will be added to the individual gala event information on the event page of the Club Website.

If a swimmer is ill and wishes to withdraw a few days before a competition please inform the Coach who in turn will let the Competition Secretary know so that the swimmer can be withdrawn officially from the gala. If a swimmer is ill on the day of the gala then please text the Coach with the information so that they can withdraw the athlete as soon as possible, as in some galas the Club will be fined if a swimmer does not show for their event. Refund of entry fees in these cases are at the discretion of the individual Gala organisers and a medical certificate may be requested. *JW*



Swimming terms ... "I", "J" and "K" are for...



We continue our glossary of some common swimming terms with I, J and K...

Individual Medley or IM

A race comprising all four strokes in the following order butterfly, backstroke, breaststroke and front crawl.

Juniors

Swimmers aged 16 and under at 31st December in the year of competition.

Kick Sets

Lengths, using legs only.

Kickboard

A flat rectangular piece of foam used in kick sets.

WORLD RECORD FROM JOSEF

Josef Craig has been at it again. Competing in the British Championships Josef swam to another world record in his number one event the 400 Freestyle. Knocking over a second off his previous record set in the Paralympics Josef swam to win the gold medal closely followed by his rival Jonathan Fox. This superb swim was followed up by a further gold medal in the 100

freestyle and a silver in the 50 freestyle.

NERs Age Group Championships

The second weekend of the NER age group championships were again held at Sheffields Ponds Forge. Rachel Taylor was again amongst the medals collecting a bronze medal in 200 breaststroke in a close race. Dori An was also in the medals winning his first ever NER medal - a bronze medal in the 10 years 400 freestyle in an massive PB swim. Dylan Pinnock was again in good form competing in a range of events the highlight being the final swim of the weekend, the final of the boys 13 years 400 freestyle in which he took over 5 seconds of his heat swim to finish in 7th position. Also racing over the weekend was Molly Momat who returned from illness to produce a PB swim in the 100 butterfly, Owen Andre who swam a PB in the 200 backstroke finishing in a very respectable 13th position and last but not least Amber Rodgers finished 27th in the girls 12 years 200 backstroke.

Junior League Final

A massive congratulations to all swimmers who represented South Tyneside in the Junior League Final. The team again led by Dot Houston finished in a fantastic 3rd position and again won the cannon. A huge thank you to everyone who helped out on what was a fantastic day for everyone involved.

Derwentside Charity Meet
