

Derwentside ASC "Charity Swim": Meet Conditions

7-8 June 2013

(Held under ASA Laws & ASA Technical Rules)

- 1) Meet to be held at The Louisa Centre, Stanley – the Pool length is 25m of variable depth with 6 lanes & anti-wave lane ropes; a separate swim down facility is available
- 2) Colorado Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times displayed are for information only
- 3) Age groups/Events will be:
 - 9 years: 50m and 200m form strokes, 200m IM;
 - 10/Over years: 50m, 100m and 200m form strokes, 200m IM;
 - All events will be Heat Declared Winner
- 4) Entries will be accepted on a first come, first served basis: **No entries before 22 April 2014**
- 5) Entry times must be within the accompanying QTs
- 6) Entry times should be converted to 25m pool times by use of ASA Conversion Tables
- 7) Ages are as at 8 June 2014
- 8) Entry fees: £5.00 paper entries, £4.50 Sportsystem Entry Manager entries
Coach passes cost £15.00 which includes programme, startsheets and refreshments
Coaches will not be permitted on poolside without the necessary pass
- 9) Entries must be submitted on the Entry Manager file or form and include the swimmer's full date of birth. Entries should be returned, together with the appropriate entry fee, to:

- 10) Cheques should be made payable to "Derwentside ASC". A valid email address or SAE must be supplied for entry confirmation
- 11) **Entries which are not countersigned by an official from the swimmer's club will be returned.**
- 12) Derwentside ASC will **NOT** be responsible for any unaccompanied swimmers on the poolside. The responsibility falls on the club entering the swimmer, who should appoint an individual to be on the poolside i.e. an adult with a coach's pass
- 13) Heats will be seeded according to submitted entry times
- 14) Awards will be made to the first three in each age group: 9-10, 11-12, 13-14, 15/Ov
- 15) Swimmers will be permitted to compete for only one club during the meet
- 16) For safety reasons only swimmers who can perform an ASA competitive start may perform a shallow racing dive from the starting blocks. Where possible, over-the-top starts will be used during the meet. Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool
- 17) Admission for spectators will be £5 per day, programme £2, weekend pass £10 (includes programme). Children, accompanied by adults, will be admitted free
- 18) Coaches or Team Managers should advise the recorders of any missing swimmers at least 45 minutes before the session start. Seeded heat start lists will be produced prior to the start time of the session.
- 19) Poolside entries, £5, may be permitted if the meet has not been over-subscribed
- 20) Coaches/Team managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Swimmers failing to report to the competitive marshals in time for the start of their race may not be allowed to compete
- 21) Anyone found damaging or misusing property or equipment at the host venue may be disqualified from any further involvement in the competition and may be subject to further action from the Pool Management
- 22) Neither Derwentside ASC nor Derwentside Trust for Sport and the Arts (Leisureworks) can be held responsible for loss or damage to spectators' or swimmers' property. Swimmers are advised to use the lockers (50p refundable) in the changing rooms and not to leave belongings unattended in the changing area or on poolside
- 23) Anyone wishing to use photographic equipment within the pool area must register at the spectators' desk beforehand
