**Meet Conditions**

1. The meet will be held under ASA laws and technical rules
2. The event will be held at Stanley Pool. This is a 25m pool with 6 lanes fitted with anti-wave ropes. Electronic timing will be used – the times displayed are for information only.
3. Colorado Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times displayed are for information only

**ENTRIES**

4. Age groups/Events will be:  
9/Over: 50m and 200m form strokes; 100m IM & 200IM  
10/Over: 100m form strokes; 100IM & 200IM  
400m events are open to swimmers aged 11 and over only and will be restricted to 4 heats only for girls/boys.  
All events will be Heat Declared Winner.
5. Entries must be made on the official entry disk and be returned by the 15<sup>th</sup> by February 2016, accompanied by the appropriate entry fee. There will be no poolside entries.

6. Individual events are single gender events.
7. Age as at 20<sup>th</sup> March 2016
8. Swimmers must not have swum faster than the cut-off time shown prior to the entry closing date.
9. Entry fees are £5.00 per individual swim. Poolside passes are £15.00 and include programme, results and lunch.
10. The meet organiser reserves the right to limit the number of entries to ensure completion of the meet as scheduled. Should events be over subscribed entries will be accepted on a first come first served basis. Confirmation of accepted entries will be sent to each competing club, together with details of any rejections, as soon as possible after the closing date. Refund cheques, where applicable, can be collected on the day of the meet.

11. Refunds will not be made for withdrawals made after the closing date unless notification is given prior to the first day of the Meet and is accompanied by a medical certificate.

**EVENT INFORMATION**

1. Coaches are asked to inform the recorders, no later than 45 minutes prior to the session start time, of any swimmers who intend to withdraw from an event.
2. It is the responsibility of team managers and coaches to ensure that all competitors report to the starting area in time for the start of the race. All competitors must go through marshalling. If a competitor is missing at the start the race will start without them.
3. All entries are heat declared winner and will be seeded in entry time order. The organisers reserve the right to limit entries if necessary to ensure the completion of the gala in the allotted timescale.
4. All heats except backstroke will be over the top starts.
5. Awards will be made for 1<sup>st</sup> – 6<sup>th</sup> in each age group 9, 10, 11 and 12. For groups 13, 14 and 15&over the awards will be 1<sup>st</sup> – 3<sup>rd</sup>.
6. Age groups for individual events are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and 15yrs/Over for both boys and girls. Awards will be available for collection once official event results are published.
7. Admission for spectators will be £5 per day, programme £2; weekend pass £10 (includes programme). Children, accompanied by adults, will be admitted free

**SWIMMER SAFETY**

8. North Tyneside ASC will not be responsible for any unaccompanied swimmers on poolside. This is the responsibility of the club entering the swimmer. Adequate arrangements should be made to ensure an adult with a coaches pass in on poolside to supervise all swimmers.
9. In line with ASA child protection policy, access to poolside and changing areas will be restricted to swimmers, coaches, officials and authorised poolside helpers only.
