Meet Conditions DCASC Valentines Gala 2017

1. The meet will be swum under ASA Law & FINA Technical Rules and is licensed by ASANER as a Level 3 meet.
2. The Pool length is 25m with 8 lanes & anti-wave lane ropes.
3. Colorado Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times displayed are for information only.
4. The referee's decision is final.
5. Results sheets will be sent to competing clubs after completion of the meet.
6. The age groups are **Boys/Girls**: 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs, 12yrs, 13yrs, 14yrs and 15yrs & over with age on 19th February 2017.
7. Entries are encouraged from disabled / para swimmers.
8. Entry times must be no faster than the accompanying Qualifying times
9. Entry times should be converted to 25m pool times by use of ASA conversion tables
10. For safety reasons only swimmers who can perform an ASA competitive start may perform a shallow racing dive from the starting blocks.
11. Sports System Entry fee is £5.00 per event, top 3 boy / girl swimmers in each age group receiving medals.
12. Swimmers entering 400m events only £7-50.
13. All events are heat declared winners.
14. No unaccompanied swimmers allowed.
15. All swimmers leaving poolside must have appropriate clothing and footwear.
16. Paper entries £6-00, Late Entries on the day of the meet (if available) £6.
17. Withdrawals/late entries (if possible) must be made 45minutes before the start of each session.
18. Coach passes are £15.00 which includes start lists and lunch on both days.
19. Entry Summary Sheet and Cheques payable to: Durham City ASC to be sent to DCASC Treasurer (Address on request from treasurer@dcasc.org.uk) or Payment may be made by Bank Transfer and summary sheet emailed to: dcasc-galas@outlook.com.
20. The meet organisers reserve the right to limit the number of entries to ensure meet timings can be maintained.
21. **This will be a first come first served meet** (400m events will be limited to 2/3 heats) and the meet will close when the entry list is full or 21st January 2017 whichever is the sooner. **Entries accepted from 8AM 2nd January 2017.**
22. Coaches/Team managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Swimmers failing to report to the marshals in time for the race start may not be allowed to compete.
23. Access to poolside will be restricted to swimmers, coaches, officials and authorised helpers in line with ASA Child Protection Policy. Official passes shall be worn at all times on poolside.
24. Anyone wishing to use any type of image recording device must register at the entrance.
25. **No person may take images of any individuals in the changing areas.**
26. Only the DCASC official photographer is allowed on the poolside.
27. Anyone found damaging or misusing property or equipment at the host venue may be disqualified from any further involvement in the competition and may be subject to further action from the Pool Management.
28. Swimmers are advised to use lockers, DCASC or Freemans Quay Management cannot be held responsible for loss or damage to spectators or swimmers equipment.
29. All competing Clubs are invited to provide officials to ensure the smooth running of the meet.
