- 1. The meet will be swum under ASA Laws and Technical Rules and will be as a [Level 4].
- 2. The pool length is 25m of variable depth with 6 lanes & anti-wave lane ropes; a separate swim down facility is available. It is the responsibility of coaches to ensure that the swim facility is used correctly in the event that it is not, the pool will be closed.
- 3. Swiss Electronic Timing will be in operation with scoreboard display. Times and places shown on the electronic scoreboard are for information only, and are not necessarily the official result.
- 4. Events will be all strokes 50m plus 100 Freestyle (8,9y) 100lM (8,9y), 200lM (10,11, 12), 200 Freestyle (10,11, 12). All events will be HDW. (Heat Declared Winner)
- 5. Entries will be accepted from rankings and training times. If there is no time entered then the swimmer will be rejected from the event.
- 6. Upper limit times will apply. Swimmers must not have swam faster than the upper time limit and any swimmers entered on times above the upper time for their age and event <u>will be excluded</u>. All entry times must be converted to 25m pool times by use of the ASA Conversion tables. Entries <u>may</u> be limited to comply with session limits. Should the meet be oversubscribed, entries will be rejected on the basis of fastest submitted times in each age group.
- 7. Age Groups are 8 yrs, 9 yrs,10 yrs, 11yrs, 12 yrs Age as at 12th December 2021.
- 8. Medals will be issued to the first six places in age groups 8, 9, 10, 11 and 12 in events as listed above.
- Poolside entries will not be accepted.

10. Entry Fees £6.50 per swim

Coaches passes £10.00 to include full programme and meal. A full set of results will be e-mailed.

- 12. Entries should be submitted on disk or entry form and should be e-mailed to Julie Row on admin@newcastleswimteam.co.uk
- 13. Seeded heat start lists will be produced prior to the start of the meet. Any withdrawal should be notified to Julie Row admin@newcastleswimteam.co.uk by 5pm on Friday 9th December 2021.
- 14. Coaches/Team Managers are responsible for ensuring competitors report to the marshalling area at the required time. Failure to report to marshalling in good time may result in elimination from the event.
- 15. For safety reasons only swimmers who can perform an ASA competitive start may perform a shallow racing dive from the starting blocks. Where appropriate, over the top starts will be used during the meet. Swimmers are requested to remain in the water until asked to leave the pool.
- 16. Access to pool-side will be restricted to swimmers, coaches, officials and authorised helpers in line with SE Child Protection Policy.
- 17. To comply with the Data Protection Act you agree that we may publish your personal information as part of the results of the event and may pass such information to the governing body or any affiliated organisation for the purpose of insurance, licenses or for publishing results either for the event alone or combined with or compare to other events. Results may include (but not limited to) name, any club affiliation, race times, age category.

- 18. The use of any photographic equipment (still, video or digital including mobile phones with photo facilities) by members of the public is strictly prohibited by North Tyneside Council.
- 19. The Lead Referee for this event will be: Kevin Rand. The referee's decision is final
- 20. Admission for spectators will be £10 to include start lists.
- 21. A swimwear supplier will display over the weekend.
- 22. These conditions are subject to government guidance for Covid19 at the time of the event and may be subject to change at short notice.
- 23. Spectator numbers may be limited to adhere to Tynemouth Pool maximum centre numbers. In the event that spectators are limited this will be on a 1 adult per swimmer basis and tickets will be on pre-booking via Eventbright.

Any points not covered above will be at the discretion of the meet manager.
