Small Pool Events

(5m/10m) will take place from 1.10pm – swimmers need to be ready poolside by **1pm**. Immediately following the small pool events, the parade will take place and the swimmers will be presented with their medal and a prize.

Main Pool Swimmers

(25m/50m events) should aim to arrive for **1:30pm** so they can participate in the parade. Warm up is scheduled for 2:10pm with a 2:30pm start.

Masters/Coaches Event

Our coaches and some former South Tyneside swimmers will take part in an event at the end of the first session.

This will be followed by a short interval.

Presentation Night

The results from the club championships (big pool) will be shared at the annual presentation evening which is scheduled to take place on Friday 3rd of January 2025 at the Elmfield Social Club, Hebburn.

Tickets will be available for sale from the club gala onwards

Raffle/Fundraising

The club fundraising team will be running a raffle to win a £250 ASDA voucher or one of several prize hampers. Tickets will be provided that can be sold to friends and family in advance with further tickets available on the day.
