- ❖ Age on the 31<sup>st</sup> October 2010
- ❖ Pool length is 25 metres it has 6 lanes fitted with anti wave lane ropes
- Electronic timing system will be in operation
- The age groups are 9yrs, 10yrs, 11yrs and 12yrs (13yrs & 14yrs for 800 & 1500 only)
- ❖ Medals will be awarded for 1<sup>st</sup> 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> in age group events
- ❖ Top swimmer in the age groups events will be based on bagcats. Prizes will be awarded to the top three competitors in each age group
- ❖ If a swimmer breaks the record for that event and age group as printed in the programme they will receive a £5.00 swim shop voucher
- ❖ All competitors must go through marshalling for both heats and finals. If a competitor does not report to marshalling in time, the event will proceed without the competitor
- ❖ If a swimmer does not intend to swim a final, please notify the recorders immediately so a reserve can be called
- ❖ With the exception of the 50m all events will be Heat Declared Winners
- There is limited seating available, Chester-le-Street Council will limit the number of spectators
