Competition News - gala titles and levels explained

Swimming competitions (galas) fall into several different categories:-

- · National
- · Regional (we compete in the North East Region, referred to as NERs)
- · County (we compete in Northumberland & Durham, referred to as N&Ds)
- Open (any swimmer can enter providing they meet the entry criteria)
- · Graded (an entry time limit is applied and only those swimmers below the limit are allowed to

compete)

Individual galas are aimed at different levels of swimmers. A gala will be one of 4 levels:-

- Level 1 Long Course only. A minimum set of qualifying standard entry times is published.
- · Level 2 Short Course only. A minimum set of qualifying standard entry times is published.
- · Level 3 Long or Short Course. A set of upper limit qualifying times are published.
- · Level 4 Individual Club Championships. No qualifying time

limits are required.
The galas which the Club plans to attend are shown on the Competition Calendar which can be found on the Events page of the Club website http://www.stswim79.co.uk/Events.aspx Please make note of the dates of any gala relevant to

the dates of any gala relevant to your swimmer's ability, if you are unsure, please ask your Coach for advice. JW



Swimming terms "C" is for...

We continue our glossary of some common swimming terms with "C"...

Catch

The point in the stroke pattern where the hand feels the most resistance and begins effective propulsion movement.

Colorado

A brand of automatic timing system.

Consideration Time

A time for an event set by the meet organiser that swimmers must be faster than in order to enter.

Converted Time

A time calculated using tables to compensate for a change of pool length. A time swum in a 25m pool can be converted into an equivalent time for a 50m pool and vice versa. *JW*



Paul Robinson's Highlights...



Josef Craig has continued his fine form recording another world record in the short course 400m free at Sheffield.
Competing at National Junior and Youth Championships he

smashed his own record by 8 seconds and collected 3 gold medals over the competition in the 50, 100

and 400 free.

We had a large number of swimmers competing at the N&D championships. Over the two weekends we had a total of 29 final swims winning 4 gold, 4 silver and 1 bronze medal along the way. Medalists were Jake Whitelock (2G 2S 1B) Rachel Taylor (2G) and Dylan Pinnock (2S). Rachel and Jake also recorded championship best times for the N&D in their age groups. Well done

to all swimmers who competed. The final weekend of N&D competition takes place on the 9th&1oth March in which the 50m events and relays will take place. Good luck to all taking part.

Good luck also to the Junior League Team and Josef Craig and Jake Whitelock who are travelling to Leeds to compete in the British Gas International Swimming Meet. *PR*
